And the second thing that kind of is troublesome here is the general order against joining an organization that doesn't interfere with your actions as a police officer. There's also First Amendment implications here, there's freedom of assembly, freedom of speech issues here, of off duty actions, that doesn't affect this officer but could affect other officers. And the last thing I'll say is, it appears that the initiation comes from a fact from a news organization. We do not initiate CRs, or disciplinary proceedings against officers based upon allegations based from the media.

OFC. MATTHEW BRACKEN: And if I have

acknowledge this order at 1044 hours, just right there. And then by signing this below, you are acknowledging that and fully understand the above order given to you by Sgt. John Bartuch, regarding the requested documents and acknowledge the date of delivery of said documents to be on Wednesday, 7 February 2024 by 10:00. You're just going to put your name. You're going to print your name right there.

OFC. MATTHEW BRACKEN: Okay.

SGT. JOHN BARTUCH: And then you're

going to sign and print, and then we'll have Officer Santiago (indiscernible).

We're going to acknowledge the order; the direct order was given. This is an illegal and improper order. I know that Sgt. Bartuch, and Sgt. With that, we have no documents at all to produce, so we can't comply with the order, even if it was legal, because it doesn't exist. And do you agree with me on that, Sgt. Bracken? (Indiscernible).
