MOMENTS LATER, A MELE BLACK NOW KNOWN AS [REDACTED] (VICTIM AND COMPLAINANT) OPENED THE ENTRY DOOR AND SHOWED WHAT APPEARED TO BE A GUN SHOT/ENTRY WOUND TO THE LEFT SHOULDER AREA. [REDACTED] (VICTIM AND COMPLAINANT) STATED INITIALLY THAT HE WAS UPSTAIRS WITH AN UNKNOWN INDIVIDUAL AND WHILE LOOKING AT A GUN, THERE WAS AN ACCIDENTAL DISCHARGE WHERE HE SUSTAINED A GUN SHOT WOUND TO THE LEFT SHOULDER. EVT#05448 IN SUMMARY, R/O RESPONDED TO AN "ASSAULT IN PROGRESS" CALL AT JEWEL FOOD STORES AT THE ABOVE ADDRESS. R/O ARRIVED AND SPOKE WITH [REDACTED] (VICTIM AND COMPLAINANT) JEWEL MANAGER, WHO STATED THAT A MALE ENTERED THE STORE WITHOUT A MASK AND REFUSED TO PUT ONE ON WHILE HE SHOPPED. [REDACTED] (VICTIM AND COMPLAINANT) NEXT STATED THAT THE MALE PLACED UNKNOWN OBJECTS FROM THE STORE SHELF IN HIS PERSONAL BAG WHICH R/O OBSERVED ON THE SECURITY FOOTAGE. [REDACTED] (VICTIM AND COMPLAINANT) APPROACHED AND TOLD THE MALE THE STORE POLICY TO WHERE A MASK TO PROTECT SHOPPERS FROM CONTRACTING COVID-19. THE MALE REFUSED AND STATED THAT HE HAD A DOCTOR'S NOTE BUT DID NOT SHOW THE MANAGER. THE MALE BECAME ANGRY AND GOT IN THE MANAGER FACE AT WHICH TIME THE MANAGER STATED TO HIM TO STAY 6 FEET AWAY FROM HIM FOR HIS SAFETY. THE MALE AGAIN GOT IN THE MANAGER'S FACE WHICH NOW PLACED THE MANAGER IN FEAR OF RECEIVING A BATTERY AND POSSIBLY CONTRACTING COVID-19 FROM THE MALE. THE MANAGER STATED THAT HE PUSHED THE MALE AWAY FROM HIM AND AGAIN TOLD HIM TO STAY 6 FEET AWAY FROM HIM. THE MALE THEN EXITED THE STORE AND WAS SEEN HEADED SOUTHBOUND ON BROADWAY. THE MANAGER STATED THAT HE BELIEVES THE STOLEN OBJECTS WERE STILL IN THE MALE'S PERSONAL BAG WHICH HE NEVER PAID FOR. R/O GAVE A FLASH MESSAGE DESCRIBING THE MALE OFFENDER AND HIS LAST LOCATION. R/O GAVE [REDACTED] (VICTIM AND COMPLAINANT) A VIN. R/O HEADED TO THE 019TH DIST WHEN A MALE CALLED 911 AND STATED THAT HE JUST LEFT JEWEL AND WANTED TO TALK TO THE POLICE AT THE CORNER OF CORNELIA AND BROADWAY. R/O RELOCATED TO THAT CORNER WHERE HE MET A MALE WHICH LOOKED LIKE THE OFFENDER FROM JEWEL EARLIER. HE STATED THAT HE WAS IN JEWEL AND HE HAS A MEDICAL CONDITION AND HIS DOCTOR GAVE HIM A NOTE SAYING HE DOESN'T NEED TO WEAR A MASK IN PUBLIC. R/O EXPLAINED TO HIM THAT HE NEEDS TO FOLLOW STORES POLICIES AND HE SHOULD MAKE THE MANAGEMENT AWARE OF HIS NOTE AND SEE IF THEY WOULD ALLOW HIM TO STILL SHOP THERE. HE STATED THAT HE ARGUED WITH THE MANAGER AND ADMITTED TO APPROACHING THE A GOT WITHIN A FEW FEET OF THE MANAGER TO SHOW HIM THE DOCTOR'S NOTE. HE STATED THAT IF THAT IS CONSIDERED ASSAULT THEN HE WAS GUILTY OF IT BUT HE JUST WANTED TO SHOW THE MANAGER HIS NOTE AND BE ALLOWED TO SHOP IN JEWEL.
