ZARBOCK #17893, CONDUCTED A LICENSED PREMISE CHECK OF KMS GROUP INC (DBA:BP AMOCO) TO DETERMINE IF THE BUSINESS WAS OPERATING WITHIN THE SCOPE OF ITS BUSINESS LICENSES. UPON ENTERING, THE I/O ANNOUNCED THE INTENTION OF THE VISIT AND IDENTIFIED HIMSELF TO THE AGENT ON SCENE, NOW KNOWN AS [REDACTED] (IL DL# [REDACTED], DOB: [REDACTED]-53). THIS AGENT IS NOT THE OWNER BUT DID IDENTIFY HIMSELF AS THE MANAGER.
