[REDACTED] (VICTIM) AND [REDACTED] (VICTIM) WERE FOUND A GRAY RANGE ROVER (PLATE # [REDACTED]) WITH MULTIPLE GUN SHOTS TO THE EXTERIOR OF THE VEHICLE. [REDACTED] (WITNESS) WAS DRIVING THE VEHICLE WHEN MET BY R/O'S AT STATE AND OHIO, WITH [REDACTED] (VICTIM) AND [REDACTED] (VICTIM) IN THE BACK PASSANGER SEATS WITH MULTIPLE GUN SHOT WOUNDS.
