IN SUMMARY WHILE IN CHICAGO POLICE UNIFORM AND IN A MARKED CHICAGO POLICE SQUAD CAR R/O'S WERE TRAVELING W/B ON MARQUETTE AVE APPROACHING ASHLAND AVE WHILE RESPONDING TO A PERSON SHOT CALL WHEN R/O'S OBSERVED A BLACK IN COLOR SUV TRAVELING S/B ON ASHLAND DISREGARD A SOLID RED LIGHT UPON APPROACHING THE INTERSECTION ON MARQUETTE AVE AND ASHLAND AVE PLACING VEHICLE IN VIOLATION OF MCC-9-8-020(C)(1) DISOBEY SOLID RED SIGNAL CITATION TU-220-226 ISSUED. R/O'S MADE A LEFT TURN ONTO ASHLAND AVE AND CURBED SAID VEHICLE. LEADS INQUIRY OF VEHICLE BEARING ARKANSAS PLATE [REDACTED] REVEALED THE VEHICLE TO BE CLEAR AND VALID TO A 2018 BLACK IN COLOR, DODGE JOURNEY, REGISTERED TO A [REDACTED] FROM [REDACTED].

AS R/O'S APPROACHED SAID VEHICLE R/O'S OBSERVED A CLEAR CUP WITH AN AMBER IN COLOR LIQUID SUSPECT ALCOHOL PLACING VEHICLE IN VIOLATION OF 625 ILCS 5/11-502 (A) ILLEGAL TRANSPORTATION OF ALCOHOL-BROKEN ALCOHOL SEAL, NOT SEALED, OPEN ALCOHOL FOR DRIVER CITATION TU-220-227 ISSUED, SITTING IN THE BACK SEAT'S CUP HOLDER. AS P.O BEN #7795 (VICTIM AND COMPLAINANT) APPROACHED THE DRIVER OF SAID VEHICLE TO REQUEST VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE AND PROOF OF INSURANCE P.O BEN #7795 WAS ABLE TO DETECT A STRONG ODOR OF CANNABIS EMITTING FROM SAID VEHICLE. DRIVER OF SAID VEHICLE FAILED TO PROVIDE R/O WITH A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE THEREFORE, R/O'S REQUESTED THE DRIVER AS WELL AS THE PASSENGERS TO STEP OUTSIDE OF THE VEHICLE TO FURTHER INVESTIGATE. R/O'S CONDUCTED A NARCOTIC SEARCH OF VEHICLE. R/O KOEPPEN #18927 APPROACHED THE FRONT PASSENGER SIDE OF THE VEHICLE AN IN PLAIN VIEW OBSERVED THE REAR SIGHTS AND BACK PLATE UNDERNEATH THE FRONT PASSENGER SEAT, WHICH THROUGH EXPERIENCE R/O KNOWS TO BE A HANDGUN. R/O KOEPPEN #18927 THEN RECOVERED A BLACK SPRINGFIELD XD-40 SUBCOMPACT (SERIAL #GM155174, 3 IN BARREL) WITH AN EXTENDED MAGAZINE FROM THE EXACT LOCATION WHERE R/O OBSERVED THE REAR SIGHTS AND BACK PLATE, AND THEN IMMEDIATELY CLEARED THE WEAPON, WHICH CONTAINED ONE LIVE ROUND IN THE CHAMBER READY TO FIRE AND AN UNKNOWN AMOUNT OF ROUNDS IN AN EXTENDED MAGAZINE. FURTHER SEARCH REVEALED A BLUNT (WHICH IS THE STREET NAME FOR CANNABIS WRAPPED IN A CIGAR PAPER) ON THE PASSENGER SIDE DOOR ARM REST ANOV #P00548750518 ISSUED. FURTHER INVESTIGATION REVEALED NO ONE INSIDE THE VEHICLE POSSESSED A FOID CARD OR A CCL LICENSE. LEADS INQUIRY OF DRIVER TIMOTHY BLACKMAN (OFFENDER) REVEALED A VALID PHOTO ID AND NO CONCEALED CARRY LICENSE. TIMOTHY BLACKMAN WAS PLACED UNDER ARREST AT 0306 HRS AND WAS MIRANDIZED ON SCENE AT 0321HRS BUT REFUSED TO ANSWER ANY QUESTIONS. DRIVER WAS TRANSPORTED TO THE 007TH DISTRICT FOR FURTHER PROCESSING AT 0333HRS. FRONT PASSENGER OF SAID VEHICLE PROVIDED R/O'S WITH HER NAME, LEADS INQUIRY REVEALED PASSENGER TO BE TRAVIS KIERRA G, 03 D.O.B. [REDACTED] 1997, FROM 10323 S LOWE AVE, CHICAGO IL, 60628. PASSENGER WAS PLACED UNDER ARREST AT 0306HRS, MIRANDIZED ON SCENE AT 0329HRS AND RELATED NON-VERBATIM, "THE MALE PASSED ME THE GUN, I MIGHT HAVE TOUCHED IT AND PUT IT UNDER THE SEAT THAT'S WHY IT WAS CLOSE TO ME." TRAVIS KIERRA WAS TRANSPORTED TO THE 007TH DISTRICT FOR FURTHER PROCESSING. LEADS INQUIRY OF REAR DRIVER PASSENGER REVEALED PASSENGER TO BE [REDACTED]. SHE WAS MIRANDIZED AT 0326HRS. LEADS INQUIRY OF REAR PASSENGER SITTING BEHIND THE FRONT PASSENGER REVEALED PASSENGER TO BE [REDACTED], AND WAS MIRANDIZED AT 0318 HRS. BOTH REAR PASSENGERS DENIED ANY KNOWLEDGE OF THE WEAPON AND WERE RELEASED ON SCENE, ISRS WERE COMPLETED FOR BOTH OF THEM. SHE SHOOK HER HEAD MOTIONING A "YES" (3) WHERE WAS HE SITTING? SHE RELATED NON VERBATIM, "IN DRIVER SEAT" (4) DO YOU KNOW WHAT HE WAS WEARING? SHE RESPONDED NON-VERBATIM "ORANGE" (5) ORANGE JACKET? SHE SHOOK HER HEAD MOTIONING A "YES" ARRESTEE BLACKMAN'S CAR WAS TOWED UNDER SS#024790, ASA CHARGES APPROVED BY ASHLEY AT 0900HRS FOR TIMOTHY BLACKMAN, COURT INFO: 08 JUNE 2020.
