NARRATIVE	EVENT# 00056. IN SUMMARY, THE REPORTING OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A PERSON SHOT AT MERCY HOSPITAL. UPON ARRIVAL, THE CHARGE NURSE KAREN RELATED THAT TWO MALE BLACK VICTIMS CAME INTO THE HOSPITAL AT APPROXIMATELY 2352HRS WITH GUNSHOT WOUNDS TO THE BODY. VICTIM#1, PHILLIP MCCLELLAN (VICTIM) SUSTAINED A GUNSHOT WOUND TO THE UPPER LEFT ABDOMEN AND UPPER LEFT CHEST. VICTIM#1 WAS PRONOUNCED DOA BY DR. LASKY AT 0017HRS. VICTIM#2 ██████████ (VICTIM) SUSTAINED A GUNSHOT WOUND TO THE LEFT SHOULDER BLADE AND WAS TRANSPORTED TO STROGER HOSPITAL IN STABLE CONDITION. BEAT 111 WAS DISPATCHED TO STROGER HOSPITAL TO CHECK THE CONDITION OF VICTIM#2. UPON ARRIVAL, VICTIM#2 RELATED HE WAS RIDING IN THE CAR WITH VICTIM#1 AND TWO OTHER UNKNOWN MALE BLACKS AND WAS BEING CHASED SOUTH BOUND ON CANAL STREET. VICTIM#2 ALSO RELATED THAT THE PURSUING BLACK VEHICLES BEGAN SHOOTING AT THEIR VEHICLE AT 1800 SOUTH CANAL. AFTER BEING STRUCK BY GUNFIRE, THE VICTIMS DROVE THEMSELVES TO MERCY HOSPITAL. THE SAID VEHICLE WAS PARKED IN THE EMERGENCY ROOM FIRE LANE AT 2525 S. MICHIGAN AVE WITH 21 BULLET HOLES IN THE VEHICLE. VICTIM# 2 WAS TREATED BY DR. SCHLANSE'S OBSERVATIONS FOR A LEFT SHOULDER BLADE GUN SHOT WOUND FRACTURE AND RELEASED. AREA 3 DETECTIVES KOROLIS, #21339 AND SANCHEZ #20765 RESPONDED TO THE SCENE.
