NARRATIVE	<p>EVENT #08445 BWC INCIDENT - IN SUMMARY, R/O RESPONDED TO A BATTERY IN PROGRESS AT 2000 W. DIVERSEY AVE AND MET WITH [REDACTED] (VICTIM) AND [REDACTED] (VICTIM) WHO RELATED THEY WERE TRAVELING EAST-BOUND ON A 1992 HARLEY DAVIDSON MOTORCYCLE (IL PLATE [REDACTED]) WHEN A LARGE GROUP (APPROXIMATELY 8 - 10) M1 UNK JUVENILES BETWEEN THE AGES OF 14 - 17 APPROACHED THE VICTIM'S AT THE INTERSECTION WHILE IN TRAFFIC ON THEIR BYCICLES. AS THE VICTIM ATTEMPTED TO TURN RIGHT ON TO 2800 N. CLYBOURN AVE, HE REVVED HIS ENGINE TO GET THE LARGE GROUP OF UNK M1 JUVENILES ATTENTION SO HE WOULDN'T STRIKE THEM. FOR NO REASON, THE LARGE GROUP OF M1 JUVENILES BEGAN TO SURROUND THE VICTIMS AND BEGAN TO SHOUT OBSCENITIES AT THEIR DIRECTION. NARRATIVE	<p>IN SUMMARY VICTIM/COMPLAINANT STATED TO RO THAT SHE WAS WITH NAMED OFFENDER AT HER RESIDENCE. VICTIM STATED SHE HAD LEFT THE APARTMENT TO OBTAIN HER MAIL WHILE NAMED OFFENDER REMAINED IN HER RESIDENCE. UPON ARRIVING BACK INSIDE VICTIM RESIDENCE, OFFENDER GRABBED VICTIM IN THE KITCHEN AREA AND BEGAN SCREAMING AT HER. OFFENDER ACCUSED VICTIM OF CONTACTING HER BABY DADDY THROUGH SNAP CHAT. OFFENDER HAD GONE THROUGH VICTIM CELL PHONE WHILE SHE WAS OBTAINING HER MAIL. OFFENDER THAN GRABBED THE VICTIM BY THE NECK AND BEGAN CHOKING HER.
