IN SUMMARY, WHILE R/O'S WERE ON A CITYWIDE ACTIVE PROTEST/RIOT/LOOTING SITUATION IN AN AREA KNOWN TO R/O'S WITH A HISTORY OF VEHICULAR HIJACKINGS, SPECIFICALLY REFERENCED IN A CRIMINAL INTELLIGENCE ANALYST REPORT FROM THE 14TH DISTRICT SDSC DATED 20MAY20. OFFENDER WAS OBSERVED AT 1204 N WOLCOTT AVE. ENGAGED IN WHAT R/O'S BELIEVED TO BE AN ON VIEW DISTURBANCE, WHERE OFFENDER AND CO-ARRESTEE NOW IDENTIFIED AS LEZERREICK DICKERSON (OFFENDER) AND DARIEN SIMON (OFFENDER), WERE HAVING A VERBAL ARGUMENT WITH TWO UNKNOWN CITIZENS STANDING NEXT TO THEIR RUNNING MOTOR VEHICLE.
