EVENT #11224. IN SUMMARY R/O'S WERE CONDUCTING CROWD CONTROL RELATED TO EVENT #07783 WHEN SEVERAL LOUD REPORTS WERE HEARD NEAR 3900 W. MADISON. SOON AFTER SEVERAL OFFICERS CONFIRMED THERE WAS A PERSON SHOT IN THE SOUTH ALLEY OF 3913 W. MADISON WHERE THERE WERE SEVERAL REPORTS OF LOOTING. CFD AMBULANCE #10 RESPONDED AND PRONOUNCED HIM ON SCENE AT 1348HRS, BEFORE TRANSPORTING THE UNKNOWN M/1 VICTIM TO NORWEGIAN HOSPITAL. AFTER SEVERAL MINUTES OF CROWD CONTROL, R/O'S WERE ASSIGNED TO THE PAPER AND ARRIVED ON SCENE.
