	<p>EVENT #17729 RO'S RESPONDED TO AN ON-VIEW LOOTING IN PROGRESS AT 11116 S MICHIGAN. CAPTAIN OLSEN AND OFFICER NUNEZ CONFRONTED THE OFFENDER WHO ALONG WITH SEVERAL OTHER PEOPLE WHO WERE LOOTING THE ATM MACHINE. THE OFFENDER WAS ARMED WITH A FIRE EXTINGUISHER AND SPRAYED CAPTAIN OLSEN COMMITTING A BATTERY. OFFICER NUNEZ THEN USED HIS POLICE ISSUED BATON TO STRIKE THE OFFENDER'S HAND IN AN ATTEMPT TO DEFEAT THE BATTERY. AFTER SEVERAL STRIKE'S THE OFFENDER THEN DROPPED THE SAID FIRE EXTINGUISHER. AT THIS TIME, CAPTAIN OLSEN ATTEMPTED TO PERFORM AN EMERGENCY TAKE DOWN IN ORDER TO GET THE OFFENDER INTO CUSTODY. DURING THE PROCESS OF TAKING HIM INTO CUSTODY THE OFFENDER STRUCK CAPTAIN OLSEN IN AN ATTEMPT TO DEFEAT THE ARREST, KNOCKING CAPTAIN OLSON TO THE GROUND. THE OFFENDER THEN FLED WEST BOUD FROM RO'S. UPON LOCATING THE OFFENDER RO'S GAVE CHASE. RO'S LOPEZ, KERR, AND FENNELL ATTEMPTED TO PLACE THE OFFENDER INTO CUSTODY AT 49 W 112TH STREET. RO'S AT THAT LOCATION ATTEMPT TO GAIN CONTROL OF THE OFFENDER, WHO WAS IN POSSESSION OF A KNIFE WITH AN OPEN BLADE. OFFICER FENNELL ISSUED VERBAL COMMANDS TO DROP THE KNIFE, THE OFFENDER FAILED TO COMPLY SO OFFICER FENNELL USED HIS POLICE ISSUED BATON TO STRIKE THE OFFENDER'S HAND. OFFICER KERR WAS THEN ABLE TO RECOVER THE KNIFE FROM THE OFFENDER'S HAND. DESPITE LOSING THE KNIFE THE OFFENDER STILL ATTEMPTED TO DEFEAT THE ARREST BY KICKING RO'S AND REFUSING TO PUT HIS HANDS BEHIND HIS BACK. THE OFFENDER USED HIS LEGS TO KICK AND STRIKE OFFICER LOPEZ. DURING THE STRUGGLE OFFICER PIENTA WAS ABLE TO GET THE OFFENDER CUFFED AND IN CUSTODY. THE ARRESTEE WAS TAKEN TO THE 005TH DISTRICT FOR PROCESSING. WHILE IN THE 005TH DISTRICT THE ARRESTEE WAS COMPLAINING ABOUT PAIN RIGHT HAND AND LEFT LEG. BT 4212A TRANSPORTED THE ARRESTEE TO ROSELAND HOSPITAL WHERE HE WAS TREATED AND RELEASED PER DR. AYANLAJA.
