NARRATIVE	EVENT# 17806. THIS IS AN ON VIEW ARREST MADE BY AREA 2 GANG ENFORCEMENT BEAT 6720D. IN SUMMARY, A/OS WERE ON HIGH ALERT DURING PATROL DUE TO AN INCREASE IN CRIME CITY WIDE. A/OS OBSERVED THE OFFENDER NOW KNOWN AS UNDREA MORROW(OFFENDER) EXITING THE FIRM DTLR (VICTIM) THROUGH THE FRONT WINDOW OF THE STORE WHICH HAD BEEN SHATTERED AS IF SOMEONE HAD THROWN A HEAVY LARGE OBJECT INTO IT.
