EVENT 24957 THIS WAS A BWC INCIDENT. IN SUMMARY RO'S RESPONDED TO A CALL OF 6 PEOPLE BREAKING WINDOWS AND INSIDE THE LOCATION LISTED ABOVE. UPON ARRIVAL RO'S OBSERVED TEMPEST ANDERSON(OFFENDER),JONTAE ANDERSON(OFFENDER), AND GARY JOHNSON(OFFENDER) WITH PROCEEDS IN THEIR HANDS ATTEMPTING TO LOAD THEM INTO A BLUE HONDA UTILITY VEHICLE DOUBLE PARKED OUTSIDE OF THE AKIRA STORE ALONG WITH SEVERAL OTHER UNKNOWN OFFENDERS. 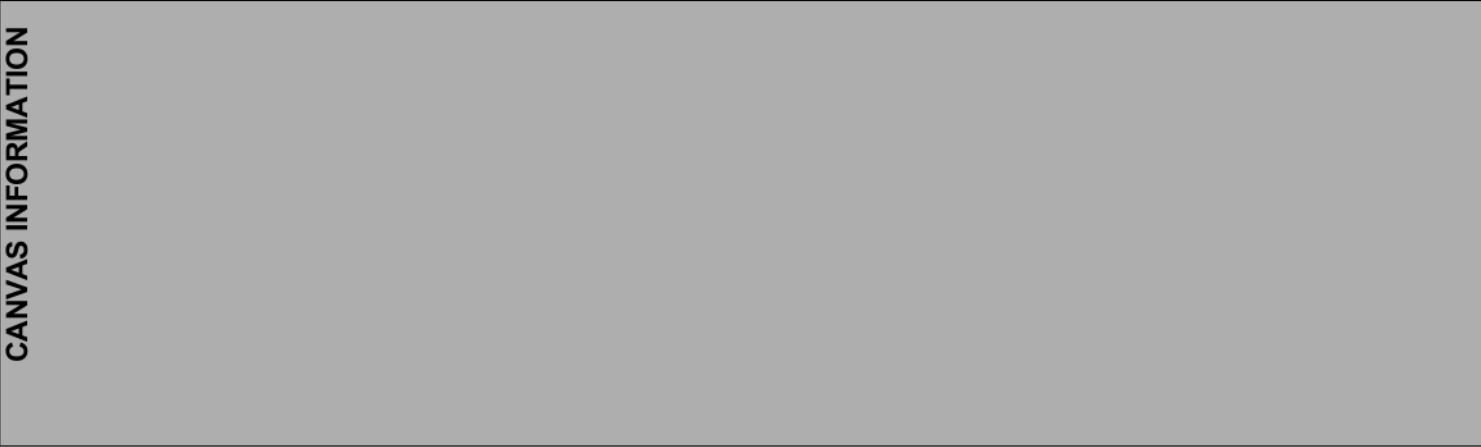
