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NARRATIVE	EVENT# 26352, IN SUMMARY, (VICTIM 2) [REDACTED] STATED THAT ON TODAY S DATE DURING WHEN THE RIOTING AND LOOTING OF STORES IN HIS AREA WERE OCCURRING HIS STORE WAS ALSO HIT. VICTIM 2 STATED THE BURGLARY BEGAN AROUND 1445 HRS AND CONTINUED TO APPROXIMATELY 1530 HRS. VICTIM 2 STATED HE CALLED 911 SEVERAL TIMES AND POLICE DIDNT ARRIVE. VICTIM 2 STATED HE HAS A CAMERA WITH VIDEO FOOTAGE SHOWING THE BURGLARY AS IT OCCURRED. VICTIM 2 STATED HE HAS VIDEO OF THE INSIDE OF THE STORE DURING THE LOOTING, STEALING OF ITEMS AND HE ALSO HAS VIDEO FOOTAGE OUTSIDE HIS STORE SHOWING WHEN THE OFFENDERS HAD RETURNED AFTER THEY HAD CLIMBED OVER A GATED BRICK WALL AND KICKED HIS REAR DOOR IN, ALL WAS CAUGHT ON VIDEO. VICTIM 2 ALSO STATED ONCE THE OFFENDERS WERE IN THE BACK ALLEY BEHIND HIS STORE THE CAMERA CAPTURED 3 M/B OFFENDERS COMMITTING A ROBBERY. NARRATIVE	<p>EVENT #23962 IN SUMMARY R/O'S RESPONDED TO A POLICE EMERGENCY CALL AT ABOVE LOCATION. THE CALLER STATED THAT SOMEONE THREW A ROCK THROUGH THE T-MOBILE STORE WINDOW. THE CALLER THEN RELATED THAT MULTIPLE UNKNOWN OFFENDERS CLIMBED THROUGH THE BROKEN WINDOW AND BEGAN TAKING ITEMS. ON SCENE R/O'S OBSERVED THE BROKEN WINDOW. THE T-MOBILE ALARM WAS ALSO SOUNDING. R/O'S OBSERVED ALL OF THE CASH REGISTER DOORS OPEN AND ALL OF THE DISPLAYS EMPTY. 1702S THEN WENT OVER THE AIR STATING THAT POD CAMERAS WERE ABLE TO CATCH THE INCIDENT. POD CAMERA VIDEO SHOWED 15 UNKNOWN OFFENDERS CLIMBING THROUGH THE BROKEN T-MOBILE WINDOW, GRAB ITEMS FROM INSIDE THE STORE THEN JUMP OUT OF THE WINDOW WITH ITEMS. POD VIDEO THEN SHOWED MULTIPLE OFFENDERS RUN ACROSS THE STREET WESTBOUND INTO THE ALBANY BANK PARKING LOT. VIDEO THEN SHOWED A GREY JEEP PATROIT AND A SILVER CHEVY IMPALA EXIT THE BANK PARKING LOT. 1702S RELATED THAT HE BELIEVED THE TWO VEHICLES BELONGED TO THE OFFENDERS. LATER 1702S RELATED THAT HE BELIEVED THE TWO VEHICLES WERE INVOLVED IN A STREET STOP AT A BP GAS STATION LOCATED AT 3201 W ADDISON (EVENT #22298). POD CAMERAS WERE ABLE TO CAPTURE THE LICENSE PLATES OF BOTH VEHICLES (JEEP PATRIOT PLATE # [REDACTED] AND CHEVY IMPALA PLATE # [REDACTED]). 1720S WAS THEN ABLE TO IDENTIFY THE SUBJECTS OF THE STREET STOP AS SOME OF THE SAME OFFENDERS IN THE VIDEO OF THE T-MOBILE BURGLARY. 1702S THEN BOOKMARKED THE VIDEO FOOTAGE FROM BOTH INCIDENTS WITH RD #249125 FOR LATER REVIEW. R/O'S THEN SPOKE WITH T-MOBILE STORE MANAGER [REDACTED] WHO RELATED THAT HE WOULD NOT BE COMING TO THE SCENE TO BOARD UP THE BROKEN WINDOW OR GO THROUGH INVENTORY ASSESSMENT. MANAGER [REDACTED] RELATED THAT HIS DISTRICT MANAGER [REDACTED] INSTRUCTED HIM NOT TO COME OUT TO THE SCENE. R/O'S THEN SPOKE WITH DISTRICT MANAGER [REDACTED] WHO RELATED THAT HE WAS DIRECTED BY HIS CORPORATE OFFICE NOT TO SHOW UP AT ANY BURGLARY SITES UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE. R/O'S ADVISED DISTRICT MANAGER [REDACTED] OF THE LIABILITY OF LEAVING THE BROKEN WINDOW UNBOARDED AND THE LIABILITY OF LEAVING BROKEN GLASS ACCESSIBLE ON THEIR PROPERTY. EVENT#25950. BWC INCIDENT. IN SUMMARY, R/O'S WERE APPROACHED BY [REDACTED] (VICTIM) AND [REDACTED] (VICTIM) WHO RELATED THAT THEIR BLACK DODGE CHARGER ( ARIZONA UNKNOWN LICENSE PLATE #) WAS TAKEN FROM THEM AT GUN POINT. BOTH VICTIMS RELATED TO R/O'S THAT WHILE THEY WERE PARKED AT THE BP GAS STATION AT 6600 S STONY AVE THEY WERE APPROACHED BY TWO MALE BLACK UNKNOWN OFFENDERS WITH 2 BLACK IN COLOR HANDGUNS. BOTH VICTIMS FURTHER RELATED THAT THE OFFENDERS TOLD NOT VERBATIM [REDACTED] (VICTIM) TO STEP AWAY FROM THE VEHICLE. OFFENDERS ALSO TOLD NOT VERBATIM [REDACTED] (VICTIM) TO GET OUT OF THE CAR AND TO TAKE OFF HER SAINT LAURENT HANDBAG FROM HER POSSESSION.
