## NARRATIVE

EVENT # 02632: IN SUMMARY, R/O'S WERE ON ROUTINE PATROL IN MARKED CPD VEHICLE AND IN UNIFORM RESPONDING TO A LOOTING OF A STORE CALL. R/O'S OBSERVED THREE VEHICLES MATCHING AN EARLIER OEMC A FLASH MESSAGE STATING THAT THEY WERE DRIVING AROUND LOOTING STORES IN THE AREA AND WERE VIOLATING CURFEW HOURS. R/O'S OBSERVED A WHITE 4 DOOR SEDAN, A GREEN MINIVAN AND A BLACK SUV MATCHING THE FLASH MESSAGE. R/O'S OBSERVED VEHICLE PULL INTO THE GAS STATION AT 10259 SOUTH HALSTED AND SIMULTANEOUSLY PULL OUT OF THE GAS STATION FOLLOWING EACH OTHER. R/O'S WITH THE ASSISTANTS OF 4214B, 4214C, 4290 AND 4214 ACTIVATED EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT LIGHTS AND SIRENS AND WERE ABLE TO CURB ALL THREE VEHICLES. UPON EXITING CPD VEHICLES R/O VEGA APPROACHED THE BLACK SUV WITH UNKNOWN BLACK M/1 IN THE SUV. UNKNOWN M/B THEN PROCESSED TO ROLL UP HIS DRIVER SIDE WINDOW WITH R/O VEGA'S HAND GETTING CAUGHT WHICH CAUSED THE WINDOW TO BREAK THEN CAUSE SMALL LACERATIONS FROM THE GLASS TO R/O VEGA RIGHT HAND AND FOREARM. THE BLACK UNKNOWN SUV THEN REVERSED AND FLED THE SCENE. R/O'S FURTHER INVESTIGATED THE WHITE FOUR DOOR SEDAN DISPLAYING ILLINOIS LICENSE PLATE # [REDACTED]. R/O'S DETAINED BOTH OCCUPANTS AND SEARCH OF THE VEHICLE REVEALED IN THE TRUNK 1 SEMIAUTO HANDGUN RAVEN ARMS CHROME MODEL MP-25, 25 CAL 2 INCH BARREL, SERIAL # 1213700, CONTAINING ONE LIVE ROUND IN THE CHAMBER AND AN UNKNOWN AMOUNT OF LIVE ROUNDS IN THE MAGAZINE, INVENTORIED UNDER #14713162 ESQUIVEL #17737 GUN DESK NOTIFIED AND RELATED GUN WAS CLEAR. FURTHER SEARCH OF VEHICLE REVEALED A SECOND SEMIAUTOMATIC HANDGUN UNDERNEATH THE HOOD OF SAID VEHICLE A BLACK BERETTA MODEL 92D, 9MM 3 INCH BARREL, SERIAL #BER255627Z IN A HOLSTER, CONTAINING ONE LIVE ROUND IN THE CHAMBER AND UNKNOWN AMOUNT OF LIVE ROUNDS IN THE MAGAZINE INVENTORIED UNDER #14713165 ESQUIVEL # 17737 GUN DESK NOTIFIED AND RELATED GUN WAS STOLEN NCIC #G984122890 14AUG2017 OUT OF BOURBONAI, IL.
