## NARRATIVE

EVENT #03124, BWC NOT WORN, IN SUMMARY, R/O'S WERE CANVASSING THE PARKING LOT AREA OF THE LISTED ADDRESS AT AROUND 0220 HOURS, AND OBSERVED AN IDLE LISTED VEHICLE WITH IT LIGHTS AND ENGINE ON AND IT WAS PARKED IN A HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE WITHOUT A VALID PLACARD (TU-137-394). IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT THE LISTED ADDRESS WAS CLOSED AT THE ABOVE TIME AND HAD BEEN BURGLARIZED DAYS PRIOR. R/O'S THEN APPROACHED THE LISTED VEHICLE AND OBSERVED AN F1 WHOM WAS LATER IDENTIFIED AS DEJANAY PITTMAN(OFFENDER) BEING THE SOLE OCCUPANT SEATING IN THE DRIVER'S SIDE SEAT. DEJANAY PITTMAN(OFFENDER) THEN AGGRESSIVELY BEGAN TO BLOW THE HORN TO THE LISTED VEHICLE. ONCE AT THE VEHICLE'S DOOR, DEJANAY PITTMAN(OFFENDER) WAS OBSERVED TO QUICKLY LOCK THE DOORS. R/O'S THEN ASKED DEJANAY PITTMAN(OFFENDER) TO STEP OUT OF THE VEHICLE AND SHE RELATED NO. R/O'S THEN ASKED DEJANAY PITTMAN(OFFENDER) WHAT SHE WAS DOING IN FRONT OF THE LISTED ADDRESS WHILE IT WAS CLOSED AND SHE RELATED THAT SHE WAS WAITING ON AN UNKNOWN FRIEND. WHILE SPEAKING WITH DEJANAY PITTMAN(OFFENDER), R/O'S OBSERVED THE FRONT DOOR TO THE LISTED ADDRESS TO BE DAMAGED AND PRIED OPEN. R/O'S THEN CONDUCTED A PROTECTIVE SEARCH OF THE LISTED ADDRESS FOR FURTHER INVESTIGATION OF POSSIBLE BURGLARY AND OR CRIMINAL TRESPASS. WHILE CONDUCTING THE PROTECTIVE SEARCH, R/O'S OBSERVED TWO M1'S RUN THROUGH THE BACK DOOR, WHICH WAS OPEN AT THE TIME OF THE INCIDENT. ONCE THE B1'S FLED THE SCENE TO AN UNKNOWN LOCATION, R/O'S CONTINUED SEARCHING THE LISTED ADDRESS FOR MORE SUBJECTS INSIDE. R/O'S THEN OBSERVED 2 M1'S APPROACH THE BACK OF THE LISTED ADDRESS AND WALK DIRECTLY THROUGH THE GATES AND ON THE PROPERTY. OFC WEBB, WHOM WAS DRESSED IN FULL POLICE UNIFORM AND WITH A BADGE THAT IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS A POLICE OFFICER; TOLD THE M1'S TO STOP AND THAT THEY WERE DETAINED FOR FURTHER INVESTIGATION OF POSSIBLE CRIMINAL TRESPASS. THE M1'S THEN FLED ON FOOT AND THE R/O'S GAVE CHASE. WHILE CHASING THE R/O'S, THEY RAN THROUGH WET GRASS, THROUGH A FENCE AND THEN ONTO A PARKING LOT ALL WHILE IT WAS COMPLETELY DARK. ONE OF THE M1'S ATTEMPTED TO RUN OVER CURB, BUT HE TRIPPED AND FELL TO THE GROUND. THE M1 HE WAS THEN PLACED INTO HANDCUFFS AND LATER IDENTIFIED AS DESHAWN BUCKLEY(OFFENDER). THE OTHER M1 WAS ABLE TO FLEE THE SCENE IN AN UNKNOWN DIRECTION. BASED ON DESHAWN BUCKLEY(OFFENDER)'S ACTIONS OF HAVING OFC. WEBB CHASE HIM IN DARK AND THROUGH DIFFERENT LEVELS OF TERRAINS; HE WAS ARRESTED FOR RECKLESS CONDUCT. BASED ON THE FACTS THAT IT WAS BELIEVED THAT DEJANAY PITTMAN(OFFENDER) BLEW THE LISTED VEHICLE'S HORN TO ALERT THE M1'S INSIDE THE LISTED ADDRESS AND OBSTRUCT THE R/O'S INVESTIGATION; AND SHE REFUSED TO EXIT THE VEHICLE WHILE PARKED IN A HANDICAPPED PARKING SPOT. DEJANAY PITTMAN(OFFENDER) WAS ARRESTED FOR RESISTING/OBSTRUCTION A PEACE OFFICER AND FAILURE TO OBEY A LAWFUL ORDER. BOTH SUBJECTS WERE TRANSPORTED TO THE 011TH DISTRICT FOR BOOKING AND PROCESSING. DESHAWN BUCKLEY(OFFENDER) HAS NO WANTS OR WARRANT AND NOT ON PROBATION AND OR PAROLE. IT SHOULD BE THAT DESHAWN BUCKLEY(OFFENDER) IS A DOCUMENTED VICE LORD. DESHAWN BUCKLEY(OFFENDER) PROPERTY WAS INVENTORIED UNDER #14713271, AND #14713283. DEJANAY PITTMAN(OFFENDER) HAS NO WANTS OR WARRANT AND NOT ON PROBATION AND OR PAROLE.
