EVENT#11040 BWC INCIDENT IN SUMMARY R/O'S OBSERVED ABOVE LISTED VEHICLE TRAVELING WEST BOUND ON 68TH STREET WHEN ABOVE LISTED VEHICLE BEARING LICENSE PLATE [REDACTED] FAILED TO MAKE A COMPLETE STOP AT THE STOP SIGN. R/O'S THEN ATTEMPTED TO CURB VEHICLE DISPLAYING LIGHTS AND SIRENS, ARRESTEE IN VEHICLE REFUSED TO STOP. ARRESTEE THEN DROVE NORTH BOUND ON CHAPPEL ST AND MADE A RIGHT ON 67TH ST. ARRESTEE THEN WENT THROUGH THE EAST ALLEY OF CHAPPEL TRAVELING SOUTH BOUND, R/O'S'S FOLLOWED VEHICLE CLOSELY. ARRESTEE LATER STOPPED AT ABOVE LISTED LOCATION 2040 E 68TH ST STATING THAT SHE DID NOT KNOW WE WERE ACTUALLY CURBING HER VEHICLE.
