BWC INCIDENT EVENT #15498 THIS IS AN ARREST BY THE 1163 TACTICAL TEAM WORKING IN UNIFORM/MARKED POLICE VEHICLE. IN SUMMARY: R/O'S WERE ON PATROL ON THE 3300 BLOCK OF WEST MAYPOLE AN AREA WHERE R/O'S HAVE CONFISCATED SEVERAL WEAPONS IN THE PAST AND A LOCATION KNOWN TO R/O'S TO BE A KNOWN HANG OUT FOR THE GANGSTER DISCIPLE STREET GANG. R/O'S ALSO HAVE PRIOR KNOWLEDGE THAT THERE HAVE BEEN A RASH OF VIOLENCE I.E. AGGRAVATED BATTERIES AND HOMICIDE IN THE RECENT PAST DOCUMENTED AT THAT LOCATION. R/O'S HAVE ALSO RECEIVED NUMEROUS COMPLAINTS FROM THE APARTMENT COMPLEX PROPERTY MANAGERS THAT GANG MEMBERS HAVE BEEN KNOWN TO ILLEGALLY CONGREGATE AT THE LOCATION WITHOUT AUTHORIZATION OF THE PROPERTY MANAGEMENT. WITH OFFICER JOHNSON WALKING TO THE REAR OF THE LOCATION AND OFFICER HASAN PROCEEDING TO WALK TO THE FRONT OF THE LOCATION, OFFICERS CONVERGED AND WALKED TOWARDS THE GROUP OF MALE SUBJECTS AS OFFICERS ZEMAN AND ALEQUIN APPROACHED THE SAME GROUP IN FRONT OF 3331 W. AS OFFICER HASAN NEARED COBBS, COBBS WAS SEEN MAKING ADJUSTMENTS TO THE BULGE IN HIS WAISTBAND [WITH HIS RIGHT HAND] BEFORE FLEEING ON FOOT. COBBS FLED SOUTH THROUGH A SIDEWALK TO THE SOUTHERN PART OF THE COMPLEX [3331 W. MAYPOLE]. BASED ON TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE, OFFICER HASAN BELIEVED COBBS TO BE ARMED THUS GAVE CHASE ON FOOT. DURING THE FOOT PURSUIT, OFFICERS HASAN OBSERVED THE COBBS RUN EAST AROUND THE SOUTHERN PART OF THE COMPLEX WHERE COBBS WAS SEEN REACHING INTO HIS WAISTBAND AND RETRIEVING A FIREARM WITH HIS RIGHT HAND. OFFICER HASAN GAVE COBBS SEVERAL LAWFUL ORDERS FOR COBBS TO DROP THE WEAPON AS COBBS CONTINUED TO RUN WITH THE WEAPON IN HAND AS HE PROCEEDED AROUND TO THE FRONT OF THE COMPLEX WHERE HE EVENTUALLY WAS OBSERVED BY OFFICER HASAN AND ZEMAN [WHO WAS STANDING ON THE SIDE WALK] DROP THE WEAPON. OFFICER HASAN IMMEDIATELY RECOVERED THE WEAPON AT APPROXIMATELY 3337 W. MAYPOLE. [SPRINGFIELD ARMORY XD 45CAL SEMI AUTO FIREARM- INV# 14711250 (UNLOADED BY P.O. ZEMAN)]. OFFICERS JOHNSON AND ALEQUIN WERE THEN ABLE TO APPREHEND COBBS ALONG THE FRONT SECURITY GATE AT 3331 W. MAYPOLE. AT THIS TIME, OFFICER ZEMAN WHO WAS STILL ON THE OTHER SIDE OF THE SECURITY GATE WAS ABLE TO GRAB HOLD OF COBBS' SHIRT AND HOLD ON TO HIM AS HE WAS STILL ATTEMPTING TO RUN TO DEFEAT THE ARREST. WHILE THIS WAS OCCURRING APPROXIMATELY 10 SUBJECTS BEGAN TO SURROUND THE OFFICERS. ONE OF THE INDIVIDUALS, D'ANDRE OTIS APPROACHED OFFICER JOHNSON AS HE WAS ATTEMPTING TO HANDCUFF COBBS. WHILE OFFICER ZEMAN STILL ON THE OTHER SIDE OF THE SECURITY GATE HE OBSERVED OTIS GRABBING OFFICER JOHNSON'S GUN. OFFICER ZEMAN IN FEAR THAT OTIS COULD OBTAIN OFFICER JOHNSON'S SERVICE WEAPON AND CAUSE GREAT BODILY HARM OR DEATH TO OFFICER JOHNSON OR THE DEPARTMENT MEMBERS ON SCENE, REACHED THROUGH THE GATE AND DELIVERED ONE CLOSED HAND STRIKE WITH HIS RIGHT HAND WHILE HOLDING HIS FLASHLIGHT TO BACK OF OTIS' HEAD, CAUSING OTIS TO LET GO OF OFFICER JOHNSON'S GUN AND FALL TO THE GROUND. DURING THIS INCIDENT, COBBS CONTINUED TO ATTEMPT TO GET AWAY FROM OFFICER JOHNSON AND DELIVERED ONE CLOSED HAND STRIKE TO OFFICER JOHNSON'S LEFT RIB CAGE, CAUSING PAIN TO THE AFFECTED AREA.
